The position, to be filled at the Assistant Professor rank, will complement expertise of current faculty. These areas of marine science may include, but are not limited to: coastal physical oceanography, environmental toxicology, natural products chemistry, ontogeny and nutritional physiology of fishes, and invertebrate biology.

The position is located at the [Marine Science Institute](#) in Port Aransas, Texas, which offers outstanding facilities in close proximity to a variety of unique estuarine, coastal and blue water habitats, including the 185,708-acre [NOAA Mission-Aransas National Estuarine Research Reserve](#). The Institute also has well developed marine education and outreach infrastructure for disseminating research. The successful applicant will be expected to establish an externally funded independent research program, provide excellent training for graduate students and postdoctoral fellows, and contribute to undergraduate and graduate teaching in the department. Faculty members commit two-thirds time to research and one-third time to teaching.
